

Cross-Zone Coordination Check

One problem this solves: Is coordination quietly breaking down between zones or units?

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- Is there one person per zone clearly accountable for what's happening there?
- Does each zone know what the others are currently carrying?
- Has a handoff or escalation between zones happened recently — and did it actually land?
- Is there one shared picture, or does each zone have its own version of "what's going on"?
- If pressure spikes in one zone, is it clear who else needs to know immediately?

This is a reflective exercise based on the RUISA™ framework — not a clinical or governance tool, and not a substitute for professional judgment, policy, or escalation protocols.

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
